On One Wheel: Cody Newman #386

Racers come, and racers go. Our sport is inherently risky and volatile, and a certain amount of attrition is to be expected. Despite this, you'll always have those paddock staples. Cody Newman is one of those staples, and he's been a part of the CVMA family since the beginning.

Most of Cody's earliest and fondest memories have been of motorcycles. He remembers being enamored with them ever since he could identify what they were. Back then, you could still catch a race on TV on ESPN. Back then, in a quaint house in Delaware, you would have found a little blonde boy in front of that TV saying to himself, "I'm gonna do that one day". Fast forward two decades, and Cody finally found himself on his first race grid with CVMA. To date, he's had over eighty starts in the middleweight class, and he estimates that he has a few thousand more to go.

"I've met the most amazing people through CVMA. I consider a lot of these folks some of my closest friends, and ironically, I haven't seen most of them outside of the race track". One of Cody's closest friends was Walter Nitto, Sr. Like Cody, Walter was a staple of the club, and he wouldn't miss a race weekend for anything. Seriously... he even missed Cody's wedding because it conflicted with a race weekend. Walter passed away in early 2015 due to complications with a knee surgery. "The loss of Walter was tough. He was the glue that held a group of us together, and it wasn't long after his passing that the group fell apart, and I found the paddock a little less fulfilling" Cue TrackDaz. Dustin Coyner reached out to Cody in early 2015 and offered him a 'tryout' for the TrackDaz program. Things ended up working out, and Cody is now a proud member of the TrackDaz staff. "The TrackDaz deal came along at a really good time for me. The group is comprised of a great group of guys that are really passionate about the sport, and they made me feel like a part of the family on day one".

Cody is also well-known for his stand-up wheelies. He gets the front tire up every chance he gets - every cool down lap and almost every lap at TrackDaz events. A corner worker at Buttonwillow took it quite personally, "that is like a personal F-you every lap." It's not personal. It's just Cody.

Outside of the track, Cody tries to stay active. He plays on a men's soccer league a couple of times a week, and he gets out on his mountain bike as much as he can. He cites 'weight management' as his inspiration for both activities, and he swears he wouldn't fit in his racing leathers if he didn't diligently do both. Cody also volunteers with the Big Brothers Big Sisters program, and this keeps him occupied for at least a couple of weekends per month. Cody lives with his wife in San Diego, and he has two dogs and a snake. The catalyst behind Cody deciding to get a snake? He handled a ball python in the paddock at a CVMA race weekend last year. You can't ever underestimate the power and the influence of racing with CVMA.
